Coordinates with supply, operations, and other activities to improve procedures and resolve problems. Directs, controls, and performs aircraft systems maintenance activities. Directs maintenance personnel employed in removing, disassembling, inspecting, repairing, reassembling, installing, testing, and modifying egress, fuel, hydraulic, in-flight refueling, and electrical and environmental aircraft systems and components. Solves maintenance problems with aircraft systems and related equipment. Inspects and evaluates aircraft systems maintenance work and activities. Evaluates work for compliance with directives, policies, and standards. Inspects maintenance activities and evaluates resource use. Interprets inspection findings and recommends corrective action.
