The Ricks Memorial Trophy is named for Major General Earl T. Ricks, former chief, AF Division, National Guard Bureau, and is donated by the Air Force Association.

AN EDITORIAL

An informal survey conducted during field training involved contacts with 73 airmen selected at random. Although this sample is only about 13% of all airmen assigned, the survey findings provide food for thought.

Of the 73 airmen interviewed:

- -- all 73 knew their Air Force Service Number.
- -- 65 knew their awarded AFSC; but only 45 knew that "AFSC" stands for "Air Force Specialty Code".
- -- only two failed to correctly identify their immediate supervisor; five failed to identify their Officer-in-Charge.
- -- nine failed to identify their OJT Trainer.
- -- 11 were not able to identify the Group Commander, Lt. Col. Robert B. Maguire, by name.
- -- 18 were not able to identify their Squadron Commander.
- -- 25 did not know who their Squadron OJT NCO is.

The above findings are by no means conclusive, but they do indicate room for improvement in keeping well-informed.

A well-informed airman is a well-equipped airman, better able to do his job. Supervisors take heed.

PERSONNEL CAUTIONED ON DUAL PAYMENTS FOR PERFORMANCE OF DUTY

All personnel are reminded that they cannot perform more than one type of training on the same day.

For example, an officer on orders performing "alert duty" is not authorized to perform "equivalent training" on his off-duty days.

Another example. An airman on orders performing "Year Round Field Training" is not authorized to perform "appropriate duty" on the same day or days.

Persons who have been involved in overpayments for performance of more than one type of training during the same day or days will be contacted for repayment purposes. Check your hand-out on the subject of Unit Training assemblies.
