## 154TH CAGE TEAM RUNNER-UP IN OAHU PLAY

The 154th Fighter Group was ably represented in the Oahu Finals of the HNG Basketball Tournament held 5 Nov. In an uphill battle which saw the Co. A, 227th Engineers jump to an early lead, the 154th was barely defeated 59-58.

In earlier games the 154th defeated the 169th ACWRON team to earn the privilege of representing the Hawaii Air Guard in the Oahu play-offs.

The team also scored victories over 298th Artillery, 299th Infantry, and 1st Missile Battalion, but lost to the Engineers 55-54 in regular play. Both finalists took identical 3-1 records into the Oahu championship play-off.

Team Captain A1C Winston Healy accepted the Oahu Runner-up trophy for the 154th. A2C Paul Trepte was awarded the Tournament High Scorer Trophy.
