NEW AIR FORCE JET CARGO AIRCRAFT UNVEILED

The Air Force's newest all jet cargo aircraft, the C-141A Starlifter, was recently unveiled at the Lockheed-Georgia Plant. The aircraft is designed to provide Air Force global airlift and deployment of combat troops and equipment.

Powered by four turbofan engines mounted on pylons under sweptback wings, the Starlifter is 145 feet long, 39 feet high, has a wingspan of 160 feet, and is larger than any other passenger or cargo jet now flying. It has maximum cruising speed of 550 m. p. h.

Despite its size and ability to fly any ocean non-stop, the C-141A will have the shortest takeoff and landing capability of any jet transport. The aircraft is scheduled to fly in December 1963 and enter the AF inventory in early 1965.
