Interested Officers and Airmen desiring to compete in an all military hi-powered shooting matches are asked to contact Msgt S. Amor at 441734 as soon as possible.

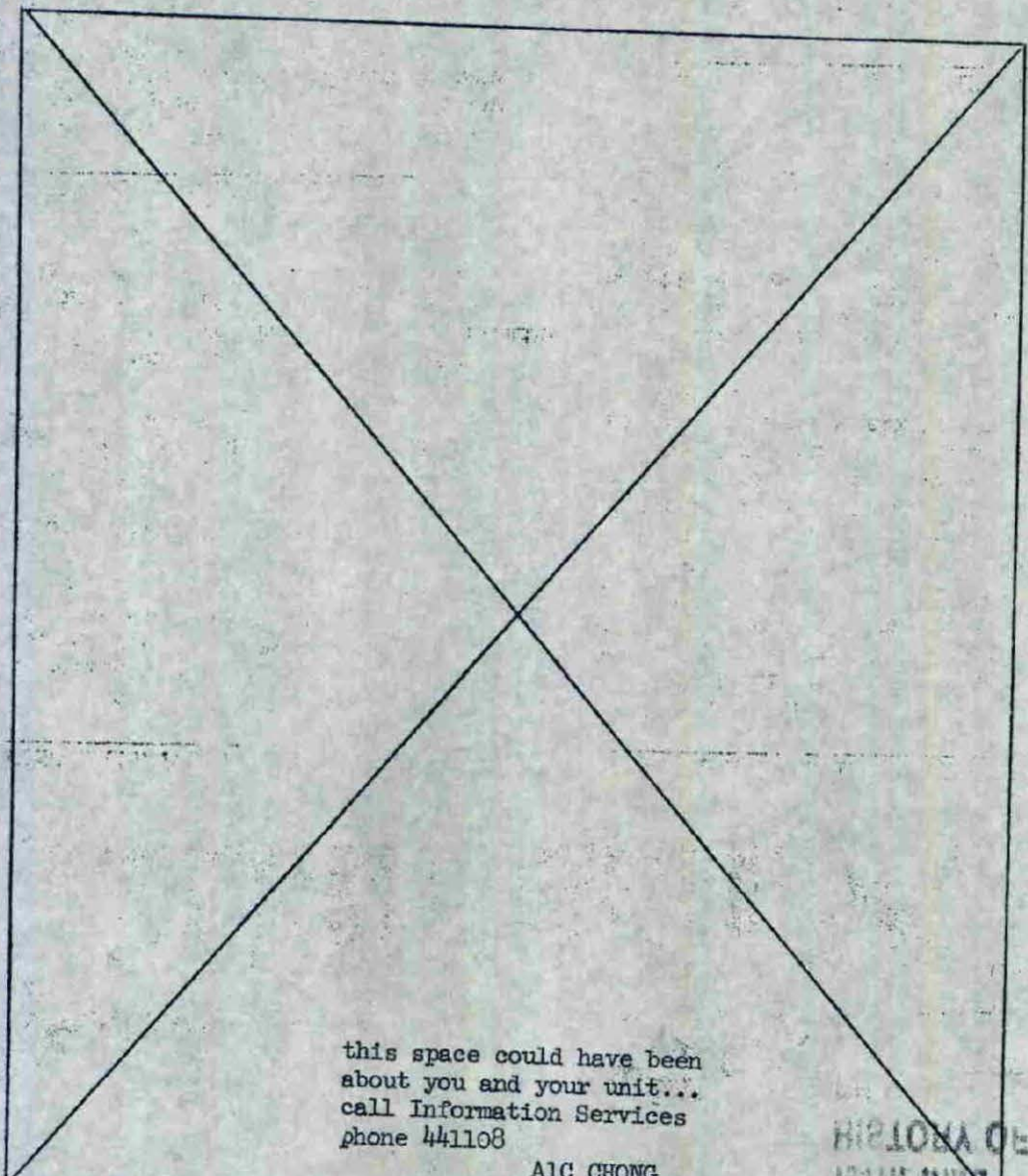
Practice sessions for those who wish to turn out will be held. Only those qualified in these sessions will represent the 154th Fighter Group.
