DEUCES SHARE "PAD" WITH AF THUNDERCHIEFS

Six Air Force F-105 Thunderchief tactical jet fighters have been the added attractions among the Hawaii Air Guard's F-102A aircraft.

The visitors are from Kadena AFB, Okinawa, and are in Hawaii to participate in joint Army - Air Force training exercises on the Big Island. This is the first time that PACAF jet fighters are taking part in ground-air maneuvers in the Pohakuloa training area.

Maintenance of the aircraft is being done by regular USAF personnel.

ECI COURSE REMINDERS

Students enrolled in ECI-Course 2A, Squadron Officer School Course, have two years from date of enrollment or until 30 March 1965 (whichever date is sooner) to complete the course. The cutoff date in March was set to give every student the full two-year period of enrollment allowed in this course.
