**PERFORMANCE WORK STATEMENT  
FOR  
PAINTING OF HAWAII AIR NATIONAL GUARD VEHICLES**

**1. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES.** The contractor shall provide all, tools, supplies, equipment, transportation and labor necessary to supply and install 4 post vehicle lift. Note: Contractor to provide their own forklift and operator to off-load equipment.

**1.1. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES.** The contractor shall perform the required services to include installation of new 4 post lift (to include air and electrical connections), and operation check. Note: A certified weight test is not required and will be provided by a third party vendor.

**1.2. CORRECTIVE MAINTENANCE.** Items other than the installation process will be noted and advised to 154 Logistics Readiness Squadron/ Vehicle Maintenance.

**1.3. REPORTS.** The contractor shall provide a report of all maintenance and servicing accomplished when completed to include a receipt. The reports shall include a record of infractions found, labor time allocated for removal and installation cost. All records, documents, and associated papers provided by the Government or generated during the period of this contract become government property and will be returned to the government upon contract termination or completion. During the contract period, all records, documents, and associated papers will be available for Government review.

**1.4. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.** The contractor shall ensure that the purchase, use, handling, storage, and disposal of all toxic, hazardous and special materials and wastes are in accordance with federal, state and local environmental protection regulations.

**2. GOVERNMENT FURNISHED PROPERTY AND SERVICES.** No Government furnished equipment needed.

**3. GENERAL INFORMATION.**

**3.1. QUALITY CONTROL.** Contractor shall develop and maintain a quality program to ensure maintenance and repair services are performed in accordance with OSHA and other applicable standards and the manufacturer's instructions.

**3.2. QUALITY ASSURANCE.** The government will evaluate the contractor's performance in accordance with the Quality Assurance Surveillance Plan.

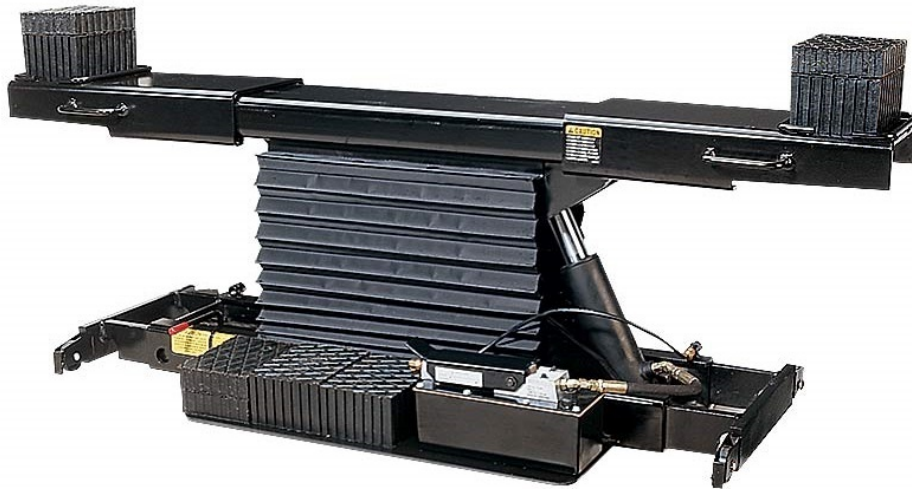
**3.3. GOVERNMENT REMEDIES.** The contracting officer shall follow the requirements of FAR 52.212-4, Contract Terms and Conditions for Commercial Items (May 1997), for contractor's failure to correct nonconforming services.

**3.4. SECURITY REQUIREMENTS.** Government employee will escort contractor when necessary to perform estimates.
