**SIREN TESTING IN MAUI COUNTY**  
**September 28, 2016**

**HONOLULU** — Hawaii Emergency Management Agency (HI-EMA), together with the Maui County Civil Defense Agency, will conduct siren testing in Maui County at the following location during the respective date and time listed below:

**Wednesday, September 28 (9 a.m. – 12 p.m.)**

- New Development Siren at Mahana Estates in Kapalua

Residents nearby may hear the siren sound six to eight times for 30-second to one-minute intervals during the identified timeframe. Testing will include short blasts known as “burps.” During the tests, emergency management officials and technicians will check that installation work on this siren has been completed properly.
