

Four maps with location marked (including Lat/Long). As of 9/26/2016, these four are required:

1. Aerial, using Google Maps or Google Earth (this also gives you the Signed Degrees Lat/Long in case it's not provided);
2. FIRMette;
3. Wetlands map; and
4. Topographical map.

Instructions for each

1. Aerial

- a. Google Maps (www.google.com/maps):
 - i. Type in the location/address
 - ii. Zoom in
 - iii. Right Click and Select "What's here?" to include Lat/Long
 - iv. Screen Shot
 - v. Edit accordingly
- b. Google Earth (www.google.com/earth - these directions for the downloaded free version):
 - i. Type in the location/address
 - ii. Zoom in
 - iii. Screen shot (Lat/Long should be provided at the bottom of the image. Be sure you have the correct location marked.)
 - iv. Screen Shot
 - v. Edit accordingly
