

# Hawai'i families impacted by the March Kona Low Storms

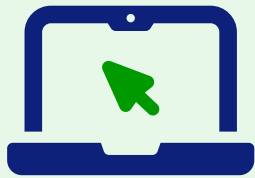
## Apply to FEMA by May 14

You may be eligible for a one-time Serious Needs Assistance (SNA) payment from FEMA of **up to \$790** to help with urgent needs like food, water, medication, baby supplies, personal hygiene items, fuel, and other emergency supplies.

If your household experienced storm-related impacts such as damage, inaccessibility, extended utility outage, or uninsured or underinsured disaster-related needs, apply today!

To be considered for Serious Needs Assistance (SNA), you **MUST** apply by Thursday, May 14, 2026

### What to have ready when applying:

- Your current phone number and mailing address
- Address of damaged home
- Your Social Security number
- Insurance information, if any
- Brief description of damage or storm impacts
- Bank account and routing number (if you want direct deposit)



### Get in-person help.

A dozen local recovery centers are open statewide including on O'ahu, Moloka'i, Maui and Hawai'i. Find a list of centers at [ready.hawaii.gov](http://ready.hawaii.gov).
