

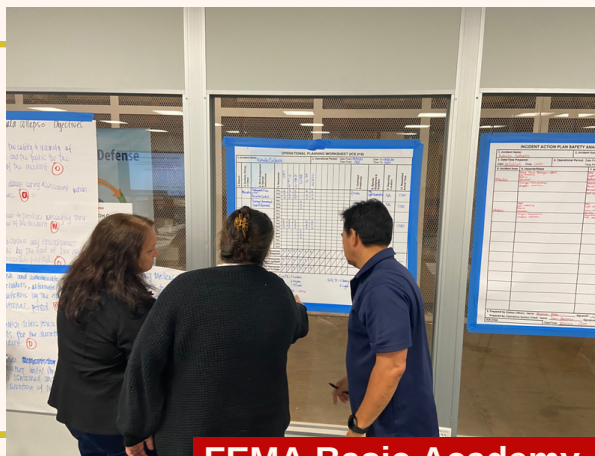

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FEMA Basic Academy – Final 2026 Course Offerings

Two final opportunities remain to participate in the 2026 FEMA Basic Academy course offerings hosted by HI-EMA on O'ahu. Courses may be taken individually, or participants may complete them as part of the five-course series to earn the FEMA Basic Academy Certificate of Completion. **L102: Fundamentals of Threats & Hazards** will be held September 14–16, 2026 (NETC Invite Code: HI102) and **L146: Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP)** will be held September 17–18, 2026 (NETC Invite Code: HI146).

Makani Pahili 2027 - Concept & Objectives/Initial Planning Meeting

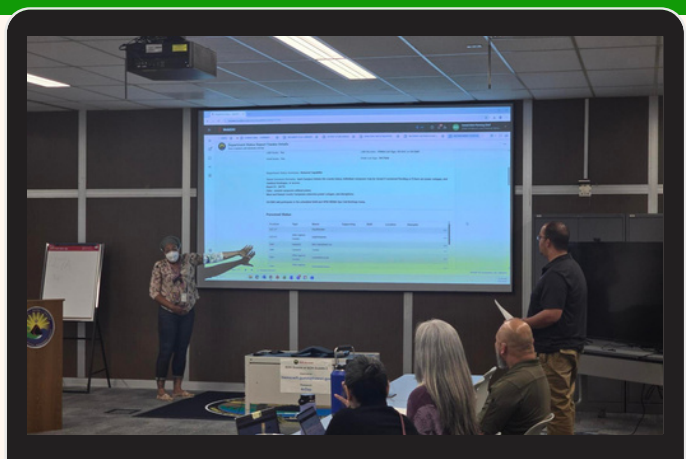
