SEALED BIDS for furnishing labor, materials, tools and equipment for "Diamond Head Crater, M-Tunnel Repairs, State of Hawaii, Department of Defense, Job No. CA-1428-C" will be received in the Engineering Office, State of Hawaii, Department of Defense, located in Building 306-A, Room 228, 3949 Diamond Head Road, Honolulu, Hawaii, up to 2:00 P.M. on June 23, 2016 and will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids may also be mailed to State of Hawaii, Department of Defense, 3949 Diamond Head Road, Honolulu, HI, 96816-4495, ATTN: HIENG, Room 228. Bids must be received in the Engineering Office, Room 228, prior to the time and date fixed for opening to be considered. All bids received in the Engineering Office after the time and date fixed for opening will not be considered.

Proposed work generally consists of, but not limited to the following: Clearing and grubbing of vegetation above tunnel crowns, application of herbicide to inhibit plant growth, sounding of existing shotcrete finish to determine the limits of removal of loose and unsound shotcrete, removal and disposal of loose and unsound shotcrete, application of new shotcrete finish (to match adjacent existing finish), restoration of existing drainage swales above the tunnel crown, hazardous material abatement and disposal, and associated work.

The estimated cost is between \$250,000 and \$500,000.

All interested parties are invited to attend a voluntary pre-bid meeting and the State conducted site visit. The pre-bid meeting and the accompanying State conducted site visit will be held at **Diamond Head Crater**, **Honolulu**, **HI on June 1**, **2016 at 9:00 AM**. The site visit will immediately follow meeting. **Bidders shall assemble in the area adjacent to the chained entry adjacent to Tunnel M-5 (refer to Site Plan for location)**.

Due to the secure nature of the facility and availability of appropriate government personnel to escort visitors, attendance at this scheduled site visit is encouraged. No other date or time for a site inspection of the tunnels will be scheduled or allowed. Bidders shall also take note that parking may be limited. Therefore, bidders shall make their own arrangements as may be necessary to ensure they will be on-time for the pre-bid meeting and site visit.

Each Bidder shall bring their own flashlight and small tools that may be required to inspect the premises.

General Engineering Contractors holding an 'A' license and General Building Contractors holding a 'B' license are reminded that due to the Hawaii Supreme Court's January 28, 2002 decision in Okada Trucking Co., Ltd. v. Board of Water Supply, et al., 97 Haw. 450 (2002), they are prohibited from undertaking any work, solely or as part of a larger project, which would require the General Contractor to act as a specialty Contractor in any area in which the General Contractor has no license.

Bidders are solely responsible to review the project requirements, determine the appropriate licenses required, and ensure that they possess and that the Subcontractor(s) listed in their OFFER FORM possess the necessary specialty licenses to perform the work for this project.
