MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPRENTICESHIP

- 1) Applicant shall be not less than eighteen (18) years of age and may be required to show proof.
- 2) Applicant shall possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent *preferred*, or be able to show proof of at least a 10th grade education.
- 3) Applicant shall possess a valid driver's license when submitting an application and at the start of the Pre-Construction Evaluation course.

Journey Worker wages are \$28.70 - \$31.30 an hour plus fringe benefits that total \$44.91 - \$47.51 an hour, after completion of the two year apprenticeship program.
