POSITION: Supervisory Air Battle Manager, 13B3C, POSNR 1121000R, FAC 135000, 169<sup>th</sup> Air Defense Squadron (ADS), Hawaii Air National Guard, Hawaii (HIANG) (To establish a List of Eligible)

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-Time Military Duty (Title 32, USC 502(f)) – Three (3) year tour length.

LOCATION: Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii

RECRUITMENT AREA: Present Lt Col (O-5) of the 169<sup>th</sup> Air Defense Squadron. (Pending availability of controlled grade) (**See NOTES TO APPLICANTS**)

SUMMARY OF DUTIES: Manages and directs the activities of the Battle Control Center (BCC) mission and air battle management functions. Determines the Operations Section's goals that are the foundation for long and short range planning and execution of all programs. Develops objectives, direction, and guidance for operations functions and activities ensuring operational and organizational plans support the vision and goals of the squadron commander. Analyzes and plans funds, equipment, manpower, and facilities to ensure proper resourcing and utilization to meet the mission. Provides employees with advice, counsel or instruction on both work and administrative matters. Coordinates directly with supervisory personnel of the BCC, fighter squadrons, adjacent command and control centers, and other flying units on air defense activities; with FAA on the safe control of air traffic; and with maintenance supervisors on operational requirements and maintenance problems affecting operations. Maintains an effective leadership/career development program. Makes critical judgments and on-the-spot decisions regarding the safety of assigned personnel. Maintain qualification as a CMR Mission Crew Commander and be certified as an Air Defense Director.
