SUBJECT: Command Leadership and Staff Assignment Waiver for Rank First, Middle Initial, Last Name

1. References.

a. National Guard Bureau Technician Personnel Regulation (TPR) 303, Military Technician Compatibility, 25 August 2005, supersedes NGR 600-25/ANGI 36-102.

b. National Guard Bureau Technician Personnel Regulation (TPR) 715, Voluntary and Non-Disciplinary Actions, 13 July 2007.

c. National Guard Regulation (NGR) 600-200, Enlisted Personnel Management, paragraphs 3-6, 3-14(g), 4-6, and 4-12, 31 July 2009.

d. Memorandum, ARNG-HRH, 13 September 2011, subject: Army National Guard (ARNG) Active Guard Reserve (AGR) and Military Technician (MT) Command Leadership and Staff Assignment Policy (CLASP) and Procedures (NGB Policy Memo #11-028).

e. Resource Guide to the National Guard Technician Compatibility Program, NGB-J1-TNS, 1 October 2012.

2. Policies, regulations, and laws applicable to the Military Technician Program require that dual status technicians be assigned to military positions that are compatible with their full-time

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positions. Additionally, Full-Time Support (FTS) Soldiers assigned to brigade, battalion, and company command; headquarters commandant, platoon leader, command sergeant major, and first sergeant positions fall under the ARNG-HRH Command Leadership and Staff Policy (CLASP). Full-Time Support Soldiers in these positions require waivers not-to-exceed 3 years.

3. In accordance with governing regulations and policies, a command and leadership assignment waiver is approved for **Rank First Name Last Name** in order for him to serve as **Position CLASP waiver is for (Ex. Commander, First Sergeant, Provost NCO, etc)** while assigned to **Unit, Para-Line, MOS. (Ex D Company 29th BSB, Para-Line: 222-21, MOS 48H2BO.)**

4. This command and leadership assignment waiver will be valid for a single period not-to-exceed three years from the date of this memorandum.

5. This is a one-time waiver for the **Position wavier is for position**. No exceptions will be granted for future assignments in a similar position at this organizational level.

6. **Rank Last Name** is currently employed in a dual status technician position as an **Technician Job Title, (Technician PD Number), Pay Grade at Location of Technician Job. (Ex. Budget Contract Supervisor (D1577050), GS-0961-12 at Joint Force HQ-HI.)** His position is compatible with Officer Branch; 67A, 67J, 70 B, 70H, and 70K.

7. Upon expiration of this waiver, **Rank Last Name** will need to be assigned to a military position with a compatible MOS and unit. In accordance with TPR 303, **Rank Last Name's (Ex. unit of military assignment must be any compatible position in a unit located within the State.)** Failure to become compatible with his technician position may result in the termination of his technician employment IAW TPR 715, section 3-2.
