POSITION: Commander, AFSC 91C0 (Commander, 201st Combat Operations Squadron, POSNR 0877643) Unit of Assignment: 201st Combat Operations Squadron, 201st Air Operations Group, Hawaii Air National Guard, Hawaii.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-Time Military Duty (Title 32, USC 502(f)) – Three (3) year tour length/On-Board AGRS see Paragraph **(See NOTES TO APPLICANTS)**

LOCATION: Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii

CLOSING DATE: 10 November 2017

RECRUITMENT AREA: Current, on-board AGRs in the Hawaii Air National Guard; AFSC: 11FXX; Col (O-6) or Lt Col (O-5) Time-in-Grade Eligible for Col (O-6)

SUMMARY OF DUTIES : Provide trained and qualified Air Operations Center (AOC) Command and Control (C2) capabilities to integrate into MAJCOM AOCs worldwide. The state mission is to provide support to civil authorities, as directed by the Governor, for disaster relief, public safety, search and rescue, and civil defense, and Continuity of Operations. This position requires mastery level knowledge of air campaign strategy, combat plans, combat operations and the integration of Intelligence Surveillance and Reconnaissance Division (ISR/D) assets required for successful execution. Must be trained and ready to function in a senior level position in a coalition AOC reporting to the Combined/Joint Force Air Component Commander (C/JFACC). Accordingly, must direct all actions that prepare unit members to perform at the operational level of war in an AOC. Responsibility to possess a working knowledge of Air Force Weapon Systems and their capabilities, as well as a clear understanding of the systems and capabilities of other DOD components, NATO nations, and other coalition partners. This mastery level knowledge is required to sustain the development and execution of a daily Air Tasking Order for a minimum of 30 days at 500 missions per day.

- Determines squadron goals for long and short range planning and execution of all programs.
- Provides direction and leadership to unit members, including full-time air technicians, AGRs and traditional Guardsmen.
- Accomplishes, through subordinate supervisors, the mission training program.

- Directs organizational mission capability through a series of extensive Air Force inspections.
- There is frequent contact with senior leadership in PACAF, PACOM, PACFLEET, CENTCOM, Numbered Air Forces, NGB, and state JFHQ, often to establish policy or to advance unit operational initiatives to include reach back and Distributed Mission Operations (DMO).
- Maintains leading edge technology capability through cooperative exchanges with AF Research Labs for technology/ operational information and field testing and evaluation.
- Directs the formulation, presentation, justification and execution of the annual budget for the COS.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:
