Brig. Gen. Christopher K. Faurot is the Commander, Guam Air National Guard and Assistant Adjutant General – Air for the Guam National Guard. He is the primary advisor on all Air National Guard matters to The Adjutant General and responsible for ensuring overall mission readiness of assigned units serving communities throughout Local, State, and National levels, in support of the Governor of Guam and Combatant Commander requirements. Additionally, General Faurot is dual hatted as the Air National Guard Assistant to the Director of Strategy, Plans, Programs, and Requirements, Headquarters Pacific Air Forces.

General Faurot was born in Honolulu, Hawaii and is a 1989 graduate of the United States Merchant Marine Academy where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Marine Transportation. He has served in a variety of positions at the squadron, group, wing, and headquarters level and flown as an Aircraft Commander, Mission Commander, Instructor Pilot, and Evaluator Pilot.
