We are an important part of the Air National Guard and the U.S. Air Force.

We provide Communications and Air Traffic Control Services for the U.S. Air Force and other Department of Defense components.

Part-time members work for the Air Guard one weekend a month and two weeks during the year.

About eight out of ten 201st Combat Communications Group members work part-time for the Hawaii Air Guard.



The 201 Combat Communications Group is made up of six separate units, spread out over the Hawaiian Islands:
