Are you planning to donate your car to charity? The IRS has a new publication, *A donor's Guide to Car Donations*, that explains what is allowed. It details four exemptions for the general rule that the donor's writeoff for a vehicle that is sold by the charity cannot be more than the sale price. It also lays out the circumstances when Form 8283 must be filed and when an appraisal is required.
