

Col. Woods Of 29th to Vietnam

Army Col. Clyde W. "Joe" Woods, Jr., the number two executive officer of the 29th Infantry Brigade at Schofield Barracks left last night for Vietnam.

Woods, who became the 29th's deputy brigade commander in 1963 when the unit was still with the Hawaii National Guard, was activated along with the brigade in May 1968.

He is a veteran of World War II, having served in the South Pacific with the U.S. Marine Corps. In 1949, he joined the Hawaii National Guard.
