Brigade Petition To Be Discussed

The deactivation petition which was circulated at Schofield Barracks by men of Hawaii's 29th Brigade will be discussed at a meeting Dec. 29 at McKinley High School Auditorium, 1039 S. King St.

The meeting is being sponsored by the Citizens' Committee for the 29th Brigade.

"The idea is to inform the general public about the petition and to gain support for it," a spokesman said.

Speakers will include Har-

ry Peters, Dave Schutter and Dave Krieger, all members of the brigade, and U.S. Sen. Hiram Fong. TV newscaster Bob Sevey and Max Roffman of the United Public Workers. The Rev. Hiro Higuchi of Manoa Valley Community Church also has been invited.

Higuchi was a chaplain with the 442nd Infantry Battalion during World War II. Wives of brigade members also will speak.

The program will open with entertainment at noon.
