# Active Duty For Guard

Close to 400 Maui and Molokai National Guardsmen will have to pull up stakes May 13, when the Guard's infantry arm, the 29th Brigade is activated by the Department of Defense, it was learned reliably yesterday (Friday).

The men are scheduled to report to Schofield Barracks at that time.

The units involved are the 1st Infantry, 299th Infantry, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, Wailuku (partial), Company C, Kahului (partial), Company C, Lahaina (partial) and part of the 2nd Battalion, 299th

automobile re-licensing, dealing with creditors and adjusting bank accounts.

The call-up of the Guard is apparently due to the fact that the 29th Brigade is an integral part of the Army's Selective Reserve Force and as such stands in high priority in the event of Federal mobilization.

The mobilization of the Guard came as a surprise to most Guardsmen but many indicated it was not "unexpected."
