HGEA Moves To Help Call Up

HONOLULU (AP) — The Hawaiian Government Employees Association Board of Directors has moved to help more than 4,000 Hawaii National Guardsmen and reservists who have been called to active duty.

At a special meeting, the directors set up a task-force to call on government officials, business leaders and Hawaii's congressional delegations.

The task-force has called for a moratorium on payments of bank and credit union loans and mortgages during the length of the call-up for reservists.
