100th Attached To 29th Brigade

The 100th Battalion, 442nd Infantry, will be attached to the 29th Infantry Brigade when it reports to Schofield Barracks on May 13, according to a news release from the office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense.

Units of the 29th Infantry Brigade of the Hawaii Army National Guard ordered to report to Schofield and their authorized strength were listed as: 29th Inf. Brigade, Hq. and Hq. Co., 217; 40th Aviation Co., General Support Platoon (from California), 39; Troop E, 19th Cav., 170; 227th Engineer Co., 217; 29th Support Bn., 742; 1st Bn., 487th Artillery, (105 Howitzer, towed), 508; 1st Bn., 299th Inf., 841; 2nd Bn., 229th Inf., 841.

The 100th Bn., 442nd Inf., also is listed as having an authorized strength of 841 men.

The release said the

strength figures listed were the authorized strengths of these units and added, "their actual strengths are somewhat lower."

The release continued, "They will be brought to strength by calling reservists from the individual ready reserve pool."

National Guard officials here yesterday said high school students called to active duty with the 29th will be given delays in reporting if requested to allow them to graduate.

Fewer than 10 men are expected to be eligible for this delay in reporting to active duty.
