Students To Get Delay in Guard Callup

College students and instructors who are members of the 29th Infantry Brigade, Hawaii Army National Guard, slated for call-up May 13, may apply for delay in reporting, according to information from the National Guard Bureau.

The authorization to grant delay in reporting covers college, vocational and trade school students, as well as instructors and teachers.

Seniors may have until the day after graduation to report to their units. All others will report the day following the end of the current school semester.

National Guard officials noted that requests for delay in reporting must be made by the individuals concerned through their assigned units and must be accompanied by a document or statement from the school regarding the individual's status in school.

It was previously announced that high school students subject to the call-up may be granted a delay in reporting until after graduation, upon their request.
