Medicine, PX Urged For Guard Families

Kauai Supervisors this week have petitioned state and federal agencies to make available military medical service and PX's for the dependents of National Guardsmen being called to Army service.

their families will be provided at three meetings starting at Hanapepe at 7, a.m.; Kekaha at 9:30 and Kapaa at 1:30.

The resolution, approved unanimously, pointed out that mobilization of Co. B here will seriously weaken the economy of Kauai as well as working a hardship on families of the men.

The resolution also calls attention to fact that the callup will weaken the guard strength of Kauai in times of disaster and emergency.

Board action on this proposal will be on point to be considered when the Citizens Committee meets Thursday afternoon to discuss ways of helping guardsmen meet their finnancial problems. This group, which includes representatives of unions, business, and government, will meet in the County Board room at 1:30. Anyone interested is invited.

Economic Director Burt Tsuchiya plans to have on hand speakers who can give the answers to such things as what the military will do for the men and families; possible jobs for wives, and possible ways to help out on budget payments for homes, appliances, care, ect.
