
ENLISTMENT FOR COAST DEFENSE WORK STARTED

Beginning active work today in the recruiting of men for four companies of a National Guard Coast Artillery Corps for Hawaii, Lieut. George K. Larrison, who has been appointed by Adjutant General Johnson as head of the coast defense work, is sending out a general letter to prospective candidates.

The letter, which sets forth reasons why Honolulu citizens should enlist in the coast defense companies, gives plans to be used in their instruction, and has been approved by army officials in the Hawaiian Department.
