Briefings On Molokai And Maui

An Army National Guard team headed by Major Wendell Crockett, a former Mauian who is the judge advocate general for the 29th Infantry Brigade, will conduct personal affairs briefings on Molokai on May 4 and Maui on May 5.

The announcement of the briefings was made Thursday by Lieutenant Colonel John R. D'Araujo, commander of the Maui-based First Battalion, 29th Infantry Brigade.

He said the schedule will be as follows:

Saturday, May 4 — Kaunakakai, Molokai, 8 a.m.

Sunday, May 5 — Lahaina Armory, 8 a.m., and Wailuku Armory, 1 p.m.

Briefings of Molokai and Maui members of the 29th Brigade, and their dependents, will be held only on the specified dates, Colonel D'Araujo emphasized, in stressing the need for all involved to report to their armories on May 4 or 5.

The briefings for Guardsmen being called to active duty, and their families, will cover such things as pay and allowances, insurance, power of attorney, wills, re-employment rights, Soldiers and Sailors Civil Relief Act, and property and automobile ownership.
