## Army Won't Reconsider Call-Up

WASHINGTON (AP)—A high-ranking Army official has informed Senator Hiram Fong that the Army will not reconsider its call-up of Hawaii National Guardsmen and Army Reservists. Fong asked for reconsideration of the activation of the Hawaii units because they represented 17 per cent of the National total of 24,500. Fong saidthis was a disproportionate share. Lieutenant General C. W. G. Rich, chief of the Army's Office of Reserve Components, said he re-evaluated the situation, "but I feel the current mobilization plan is in the best interest of the nation as a whole." Rich said the 29th Brigade "is uniquely qualified to fulfill the requirements for an additional brigade at Schofield Barracks, readily usable for contingencies in the Pacific area."
