

Hawaii Guard's Offer Cordially Received

Governor Pinkham's cablegram to the war department yesterday offering the services of the National Guard of Hawaii, in view of the calling out of the border states' militia, has been received with cordial appreciation by the department.

The following reply came today from Secretary Baker:

"Pinkham, Governor of Hawaii, Honolulu:

"Cordial thanks for offer services National Guard, Hawaii. Offer will receive full consideration, but trust no occasion for services will arise.

"Secretary of War."

The Associated Press today also carried the news over the country that the Hawaii guard has offered its services. A despatch from Washington says: "Secretary Baker has received from Governor Pinkham a tender of the services of the Hawaiian militia."
