# Parade to climax Armed Forces Week

Families and friends of 29th Brigade members are expected to drive to Schofield Barracks to see a pa-

rade Saturday morning at 11. The former Hawaii Army National Guardsmen, now members of the U.S. Army, will conclude their first week of active duty by parading. The event will end Armed Forces Week. The scene will be similar

to that seen at Ft. DeRussy Monday when the men went on active duty.

The parade is not being held on Ala Moana Boulevard, the Army said, because the 29th is at Schofield and similar parades for new soldiers are being held elsewhere in the country where

units were called up. Parades were staged annually in Honolulu until the First Marine Brigade and the 25th Division went to Vietnam.

The Army will have displays of equipment available at Schofield for adults and children to look over.

A highlight of the open house arrangement at all military bases Saturday will be the opening of Kolekole pass to civilian traffic.

All bases will be open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. as will the Kolekole Pass road which can be driven from either the Luualualei or Schofield side.

Pearl Harbor will be open to visitors, a rare privilege.

Different types of ships will be flying bunting and welcoming families aboard.

Many types of Air Force, Navy and Army aircraft will be parked at Hickam Air Force Base for display.

The planes to be seen will vary from the Air Guard's sleek F-102 fighter-interceptor, to the giant C-124 Globemaster cargo plane.

The Navy will have the A-4 Skyhawk that flies from carriers against North Vietnam and the submarine-tracking P3 Orion.

There will be an aircraft display at Barbers Point Naval Air Station.

The Coast Guard will open

its base at Rainbow Island to the public and the big attraction will be the cutter Mellon, newest ship in the Pacific. The Marine base at Kaneohe and the Air Force base at Wheeler will be open.
