Married men in 29th, 442nd can get housing

All married personnel in the 29th Brigade and 442nd Battalion in the grade of E-4 with four years or more of experience are authorized to apply for government quarters, an Army spokesman at Schofield Barracks said yesterday.

Quarters will be assigned if available.

All persons residing in Hawaii who satisfy the E-4 and experience requirement are eligible to apply.

The Federal Government also will ship household effects at no expense to the Neighbor Island serviceman

if he is an E-4 with four or more years of experience.

However, soldiers coming from California or Arizona will not be eligible for government payment of household goods shipment and dependent travel expense.

This is because their assignment will not be for a normal three-year overseas tour. Their assignment is for two years.

The spokesman added that the 40th Aviation Company from Long Beach, Calif. will arrive the last week of May. The company will be assigned to the headquarters of the U. S. Army, Hawaii.
