HIGHLIGHTS OF THE BUSINESS WEEK: In Hawaii, the callup of about 3,500 Army National Guardsmen and Army reservists last week raised the total military population in the islands by about 7 per cent and will increase the military payroll by an estimated \$10-\$12 million on an annual basis. It also means a reduction in the State's civilian labor force of more than 1 per cent. Although most of the men called up for active duty are from Oahu, the civilian work force on the Neighbor Islands will be hardest hit, relatively. The impact will be centered among those between 18 and 25 years of age. Hiring of replacements to fill these civilian job openings will put additional strain on an already tight labor market.
