Married Guardsmen And Reservists Can Apply For Government Quarters

HONOLULU (AP)— The army has revealed that married national guardsmen and reservists called to active duty this month can apply for government quarters if they are in grade E-4 with four or more years experience.

Hawaii residents satisfying the requirements may apply

for quarters. Soldiers coming from California and Arizona will not be eligible for government shipment of household goods and dependent travel expenses.

The army said the expenses will not be paid for the mainland soldiers because their assignment will not be for a normal three-year overseas tour.
