## Some Island GIs to train on Mainland

Members of the 29th Brigade will gladly fall into line Friday at Schofield Barracks, because it will be their first Army pay day.

Seventy-one men of the brigade left yesterday noon for six months on the Mainland.

Some who need basic training will go to Ft. Ord, Calif.

"Others will be taking advance training at Ft. Bliss, Ft. Dix, Ft. Bragg, Ft. Jackson and Ft. Knox," a spokesman said. "We are told they will be returned to us later."

Today a seven-man honor guard of Hilo troops fired a salute at Hilo Memorial Day ceremonies.

Artillery batteries of the 29th will fire at ceremonies Thursday noon at Punchbowl and Schofield.

Tonight the 29th will begin night infantry tactics and night firing.

Firing of the M-14 rifle will be completed by Wednesday, a spokesman said.
