

MEN TO SERVE BUT ONE YEAR BEFORE EXAMS.

Cable advices from Washington to the Hawaiian department have been received here stating that enlisted men who have served with organizations for one year will be allowed to compete in examinations for promotion.

Word to this effect was forwarded this morning to the various posts of the local department and is considered one of the most important rulings that has come to army men here.

Formerly it was required that a man serve for two years before being allowed to compete in the examinations. It is evident that the reason for the rule is that which has caused the issuance of orders for officers' examinations, namely, the large number of positions to fill with the new army bill in effect.
