

GUARDSMEN OF KAUAI PRACTISE FOR FOURTH

Drills and Athletics Are Progressing With Good Prospects

KEALIA, June 20.—Companies E and F of Kealia and G and H of Eleele and Homesteads, which make up the second battalion of the Fourth Regiment of the Kauai national guard, under Maj. Walter McBryde, held a most excellent drill last Sunday afternoon. The Kupaa flats, where the drill was held, form the best drilling field in the island and the maneuvers and inspection were very interesting.

All the battalion drills which will be undertaken at the Fourth of July celebration were gone through with and some splendid work was done by all the companies. Colonel Broadbent and his staff witnessed the drills, which were directed by Lieutenant Horner of Kapaa. Later some exhibition drills were practiced that will be given by the Kealia company on the Fourth.

In the morning some interesting sports were held in Kilauea in preparation for the athletic events that will make up the afternoon program on the Fourth. Most of the battalions of the regiment were represented and some fine practice and much fun resulted.

On next Sunday, the inspection and drill will be held in Lihue. After the drill, some of the events for the Fourth will be practised; among them are the half-mile race, hundred-yard dash, relay race, two hundred twenty-yard dash, centepede race, sack race, shoe race, running high jump, shotput (sixteen pounds), carrying wounded without a litter, running broad jump, baseball throw and tug of war.
