

# BATTALION AIM OF C. A. BRANCH NATIONAL GUARD

Two additional companies of the Coast Artillery, National Guard of Hawaii, are being formed and National Guard authorities hope to have them completed by Friday.

At the present time the new 2nd Coast Artillery Company in process of formation at Kaimuki has half the men necessary enrolled and excellent progress is also reported by the Waikiki company, the third being organized by 1st Lieut. J. W. Caldwell. Meeting of this company is called for Wednesday evening at the home of D. Kalauokalani.

If the two additional companies can be mustered in there will be three Coast Artillery companies in the National Guard, and it is the hope of National Guard authorities to form a fourth company in the near future.

If this can be done, the Coast Artillery companies will become a battalion, entitled to battalion equipment and a brass band of 28 men.
