

# RIFLE RANGE ON PUNCHBOWL SOON TO BE COMPLETE

Progress on the Punchbowl rifle range being constructed by the National Guard is going along so well that it is now nearly ready for use. Several of the rifle pits have been dug and the big wooden base for targets have been completed and are now in position on the northeast side of the range.

According to National Guard headquarters, Field Company A, Signal Corps, will start the installation of a telephone communication system, by which results made by marksmen can be phoned back to the rifle pits, or orders concerning the targets sent to the target operators.

As soon as Capt. R. L. Noggle, commander of the Signal Corps Company, returns from Lihue, Kauai, where he is attending the Fourth of July celebration there today, the work of putting up the telephone system will be started.
