

REGULAR ARMY OFFICERS  
GET MILITIA COMMANDS

Twenty-nine Given High Places  
In National Guard

WASHINGTON, July 6.—Twenty-nine officers of the regular army have been authorized to accept commissions in the national guard, by orders issued from the war department yesterday afternoon. They include Capt. Wilson B. Burtt of the Twentieth Infantry, now stationed at Columbus, New Mexico, to be colonel of the Second California Infantry; Capt. William H. Waldron of the Twenty-ninth Infantry, now at Camp Gaillard, Canal Zone, to the command of an Idaho regiment of infantry; Capt. Walter Bates, now with the office of the Colorado adjutant general, to be colonel of the First Colorado Infantry; Capt. William Wallace of the Twentieth Infantry, to be a major of cavalry in the Utah command, and Capt. Arthur M. Ferguson, Fourteenth Infantry, and now at the Army Service School, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, to be lieutenant-colonel of the Second Montana Infantry.
