Engineers' Pin Disturbers Far Down In Rating Now

The Engineer Company of the National Guard now vies with Company C for best rights to occupy the cellar in the Militia Bowling League as a result of last night's matches. After losing three straight to the Naval Militia in yesterday's entertainment, the Engineers raised their total of games lost to within four of that of the C rollers.
