

Col. Samuel I. Johnson, the adjutant-general, and Lieut. W. C. Whitner, inspector-instructor, N. G. H., will leave probably Wednesday on the Mauna Kea for Hawaii, the latter to make the necessary federal inspection of companies of National Guard on the Big Island. There are now five companies on Hawaii.

The two National Guard officials will go first to Hilo, and from there will journey to various parts of the island looking over the National Guard companies.

They will be gone about a week, and Col. Johnson will probably visit Maui to see Company I, at Wailuku, and Company L, at Lahaina, which he desires to inspect. There are prospects of two more companies being formed on Maui, one at Wailuku and the other at Kahului.
