
SITE FOR GUARD PUNCHBOWL CAMP FORMALLY GIVEN

President Wilson Sets Aside
Portion of Military Reserva-
tion for Territorial Use

WASHINGTON, D. C., Oct. 14. — President Wilson today issued an order, according to act of Congress, transferring a portion of the military reservation of Punchbowl, Honolulu, to the territory of Hawaii. The rights of way and other privileges are retained by the United States. The area released is of 4.41 acres and 35.35 acres are retained for the United States military reservation.

The area transferred to the territory is for the National Guard camp, which is already being developed under the direction of Adjt.-gen. Johnson and Superintendent of Public Works Forbes.
